How the Egg Freeze, Part II Possibility Plan Works

The Egg Freeze, Part II Possibility Plan at The Center is open to all patients who do not have insurance coverage and qualify financially. The Egg Freeze, Part I Possibility Plan includes one price for all cycle monitoring for blood work and ultrasounds performed at The Center, embryo transfer, thawing of oocytes, culture of oocytes, culture and fertilization (regardless of how many days) complex sperm preparations, preparation of embryos for transfer, assisted hatching, facility fee and embryo cryopreservation. This case rate includes the procedures beginning with monitoring and ending with embryo transfer.

Costs associated with fertility work-up/checklist, diagnostic blood work and ultrasound, sonohysterogram or HSG, surgery, outside monitoring, Microfluids, Part I of the Egg Freeze cycle, Frozen Embryo Transfer, embryo glue, PGT-A/PGT-M/PGT-SR (formerly known as PGD/PGS), storage expenses, medications or medical treatment associated with a pregnancy or an unsuccessful cycle (treatment for miscarriage, ectopic or biochemical pregnancy) are not included.

All participants in any Possibility Plan must sign a Possibility Plan Case Rate Waiver.
